

Water Saving Tips

- Consider using wetting agents on lawns and garden.

Wetting agents help retain moisture in the soil on lawns and gardens, stopping vital water and nutrients draining away which means a healthier lawn and garden and reduces the need for large quantities of water. Spray-on versions are easy to use and very cheap at about \$18 per bottle which will cover lawn areas up to two times per year.

- If you are not using an area of garden.

If you have an area of garden that is not being used, please consider capping off the sprinklers, as this is a waste of water and encourages weed growth.

- Types of sprinkler systems

Look at the type of sprinklers systems your lawn and garden has, Can you replace large spray nozzles with more efficient and direct types such as mist spray and jet nozzles? These help deliver water only where it is needed and are easy to maintain and change the locations as need be.
